CONCUPISCENCE

Are you guilty of this sin mentioned in the King James Version of the Bible? It's one of many archaic words found in that translation. Here are three passages where the word is found in the KJV. Following each verse is the same passage in a newer translation.

Romans 7:8

- But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. KJV
- But sin, taking opportunity by the commandment, produced in me all manner of evil desire.— NKJV
- But sin, taking opportunity through the commandment, produced in me coveting of every kind.— NASB

1 Thessalonians 4:5

- Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God: KJV
- Not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God;—NKJV Not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God;—NASB

Colossians 3:5

- Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry. KJV
- Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.— NKJV
- Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry. –NASB
