## Love of the World

Demas had traveled with Paul on many of his missionary trips (he is mentioned in the Colossians letter [4:14] and the letter to Philemon [1:24]).

The love of the present world had more appeal to him than to continue enduring the trials as Paul's helper. (Paul was now under arrest in Rome with no hope of being released.) "Deserted me" is the last comment concerning Demas. What a sad comment.

## DESERTION

Be careful not to let the love of the world, or trials, or tough times, or the untimely death of a love one, or wanting to do something the Scriptures prohibit, cause you to question your dedication to Christ. Don't let such questioning lead to desertion.

It's even worse for a child of God to desert for some trivial reason, such as "too hard," or "too far to travel to church," or "can't stand the preacher," or "[FILL IN THE BLANK]."
